- **For Kingdom Kids, our Wednesday Night Children's program—planning, planning, planning always—God's best for His kids**

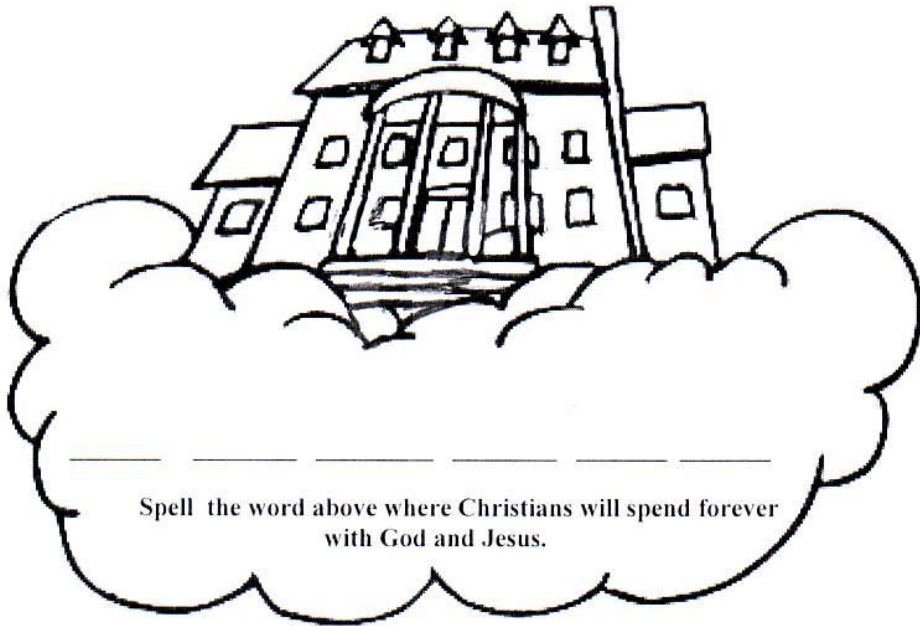
